TASTING NOTES

Aromas of blackberries, butterscotch, and anise. Flavors of dark fruits, black cherry, and spice. Full bodied profile with plenty of grip and length. This wine is built for aging, but good luck trying to wait!

A warm, dry spring and growing season resulted in a very early harvest in 2015. There was significantly less fruit than the year before (and average) but the concentration of flavors and tannins is much higher.
